## **ACCIDENTS AND INCIDENTS**

The Club carries an insurance policy to protect the club against public liability claims.

Our Insurance Company demands that walks' leaders and event organisers must report accidents and incidents to the Club Secretary who holds the "Incident/Accident" File.

The Club Accident/Incident report form should be carried by leaders with their first aid kits.

Accident Reports should include:

- . date and time of accident
- . full name and age of injured people
- . brief description of circumstances and injuries
- . name of a witness to the accident
- . state whether or not medical treatment (doctor or hospital) was necessary

Incident Reports are required for any incident involving allegations of:

- . general negligence
- . negligence regarding advice given
- . trespassing
- . libel/slander
- . damages to third party property

The names of any witnesses to the incident should be recorded.

## **RAMBLERS' REMINDERS**

On roads with no footpath, walk in single file and well to the RIGHT.

Keep in single file on paths through crops and ploughed land.

Dogs must be kept on leads through crops and in the vicinity of animals and poultry.

### **DO NOT WALK AHEAD OF THE LEADER**

Keep the person ahead and behind in sight at all times when paths divide.

Remove boots before entering a public house and if using house facilities (gardens/toilets) it is necessary to buy food or a drink.

Do NOT consume your own food or drink on pub premises unless the leader states that permission has been obtained.

Remember, you walk at **YOUR OWN RISK**.
